Summary of Property Taxes Received to Date-

Mrs. Lindsay informed the Board that two installments have been received so far, the district is still owed a little more.

Community Solar-

Mrs. Lindsay spoke about being approached regarding a community solar project, Illinois Energy Consortium. Mrs. Lindsay reported that there are solar credits that would be on the bill for about 11-12% savings. There was discussion about the new roof with units, is it worth the savings and if other schools are participating. Mrs. Lindsay will look into more information.

Financial Updates-

Mrs. Lindsay reported that with the cost of everything going up and projects going on the next four years, there are some projected savings. The contract with TMCSEA has been reduced since the District no longer needs a coordinator and/or mentor in the Special education program. The District is in the process of transitioning to free internet and the library position has been reduced from full-time to part-time.

Facilities Updates-

Mrs. Lindsay informed the Board that the drain tile and sink hole at Georgetowne has been fixed, summer cleaning is continuing and the garage at Marquette looks nice.
